## City of Mora Requires Server Training

City of Mora retailers must require all new employees who serve alcohol to complete responsible beverage server training (RBST) within 90 days of employment as a condition of their liquor license renewal.

**Selling alcohol is a job that comes with a requirement to sell safely and legally.**

RBST can help servers and managers prevent over serving, impaired driving, and underage sales. It can also help employees recognize fraudulent IDs. Many insurance companies offer a discount on insurance for establishments who participate in a RBST program.

**Most servers, bartenders, and managers want to sell safely and legally.**

RBST helps alcohol servers and sellers do their jobs. Servers can face criminal and civil liability if they make an illegal sale. Sellers and servers deserve an opportunity to be trained on how to sell alcohol safely and legally.

**Training programs help prevent sales to intoxicated patrons and underage youth.**

RBST also covers signs of intoxication to help staff know when a customer should be cut off from alcohol sales. Reducing the likelihood of sales to intoxicated and underage customers helps protect our communities and youth.

**Keep up the good work.**

Ensure that your servers and sellers, whether new or experienced, attend Responsible Beverage Server training to remind them of the basics, educate them about changes in Minnesota laws and IDs, and motivate them to keep themselves and your business safe.
